

Harboring Sin (Hate) Apostle Amanda W Bryant

Harboring Sin (Hate)! And the Lord said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt, and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows; And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them (Exodus 3:7-9). Harboring means to keep in one's mind or heart, to accommodate to shelter. Just because you are born again does not mean you are not harboring sin. God sees what you are going through, he sees your afflictions, your troubles, your heart ache and your pain. He said I am the God that sees you I am El Roi. Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all (Psalm 34:19). We have to get rid of those things that are stopping us from moving forward with God. When we spend time with God He is going to show us how to get rid of what's holding us. We all have skeletons in our closet, and we have to stop looking at other people and look at ourselves. We have to renew our minds to who we are now that we are in Christ. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God (Romans 12:2). Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new (2 Corinthians 5:17). We have to lay our lives down to follow Jesus. I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me (Galatians 2:20). Some of us are living in hate. Hate means to have ill will, hostility against a person or to hold animosity. Some of us have become so hateful that we have developed a hardened heart. A hardened heart is a heart that has become callous and insensitive, more sensitive to the things of the world than the things of God. Hate can turn into murder it may not be a psychical death, but you can murder someone with your mouth. And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing wherewith his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob (Genesis 27:41).
